The Texas Education Agency allows Blum ISD to restrict student access to on-campus instruction by offering students remote instruction for up to 14 calendar days because of a confirmed COVID -19 outbreak. Due to Blum ISD's continuing rise in COVID-19 cases since coming back from Thanksgiving in both staff and students, we have made the hard decision to have all students go remote for learning next week, December 14-18. The hope is that by going remote before the Christmas break, we will have extra time for the COVID-19 outbreak to run its course. We have every intention of starting back face-to-face January 5th. In order to ensure we are able to do this, we need everyone taking steps to limit contracting and spreading COVID-19 while out of school.

Please follow these guidelines if you have had close personal contact, or have been diagnosed, before returning to school:

If an individual has had close contact exposure, they may come back after day 10 of the exposure without testing, OR after day 7 after exposure after receiving a negative test result. If a person returns during this time frame, the person will STILL need to closely monitor themselves for symptoms for the duration of the 14-day incubation period.

If an individual has been diagnosed with COVID-19, the individual may return to school when ALL three (3) of the following criteria are met:

- At least one day (24 hours) have passed since recovery (resolution of fever without the use of fever-reduction medication);
- The individual has improvement in symptoms(e.g., cough, shortness of breath); and
- At least ten days have passed since symptoms first appeared.

Also, if someone in a household-parent, child, etc.- is exhibiting any symptoms, feel they need to be tested, or are waiting on test results, please do not send your children to school.
